How Is the Programme Structured?

The training programme is split into 22 modules. Some modules, those explaining the Teddy Tennis system take place in the class room, but the vast majority of the training is scheduled on court.

When on the court, the trainees will be required to go back in time. We expect everyone attending the Teddy Tennis Training Session to pretend to be a 3, 4 or 5 year old. This is the best way to learn the programme. Head Ted, who will be running the on court training, will deliver the training as if he were teaching a standard Teddy Tennis class with Cub Cadets. This novel approach really works and what may surprise you even more, coaches love it too!

Why Does It Take 2 ½ Days?

Even if you are the world's expert at teaching first entry level tennis, it still takes 2 ½ days to be introduced to all of the skill sessions and music created for Teddy Tennis. Ideally we would like to spend more time, not less. Apart from learning the theory of the Teddy Tennis system, the coaches have over 50 different games and activities to learn, as well as 40+ songs.
